

How to get to Ringberg Castle

In addition to the information provided below, the Schloss Ringberg website also has a [travel page](#) that offers useful tips.

Ringberg Castle is located on a hill overlooking Lake Tegernsee at the northern edge of the Bavarian Alps. The weather in December can be freezing and snowy, so make sure to bring warm clothing and sturdy boots.

The town of Tegernsee can be reached by train from Munich; the ride takes ~1 hour from Munich main station and ~2 hours from Munich Airport (with 1 transfer).

! Important: The train to Tegernsee is operated by the private company Bayerische Regiobahn (BRB). The train that leaves Munich splits at the station "Schafflach" with one part going to Lenggries, the other going to Tegernsee. The destination is indicated on each train car. Make sure you are in the part of the train that goes to Tegernsee!

If you arrive in Munich by airplane, book a train ticket in advance from Deutsche Bahn (DB) at <https://www.bahn.com/en> or get the "DB Navigator" app to buy mobile phone tickets and receive real-time information about your connections:

Enter "Munich Airport T" as place of departure and "Bahnhof, Tegernsee" as destination. Enter dates and times as appropriate. Please note that the train schedules are renewed at the beginning of December, hence the schedules may not be available yet (try again later).

If you stay overnight in downtown Munich before or after the meeting, book your train tickets to and from "Munich" (München Hauptbahnhof) instead.

Please aim to arrive in Tegernsee around 14:00 on Wednesday, and leave after 12:00 on Saturday.
